

- The new cases that we report each weekday appear as we know about them — when the COVID test result is completed and we are informed by the KDHE that the person is positive. The 14-day moving average graph shows when the COVID test was performed on each positive case, which is a standard measurement. Beginning this week, the moving average graph will not include the most recent three days to allow lab results for those dates to be completed and ensure a more accurate calculation of the moving average for these data points.
