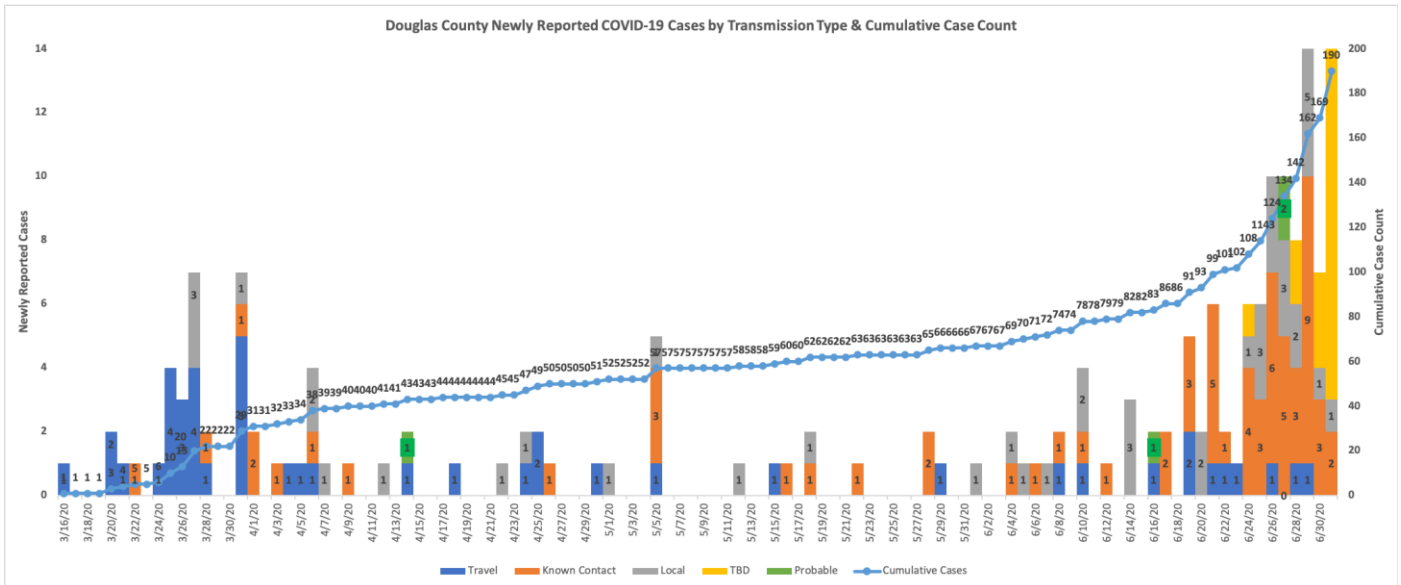

Current LMH Health Inpatients Positive for COVID-19: **1**

After a recent spike in COVID-19 cases, Douglas County’s local health officer [will issue a new order to close bars and nightclubs](#) in the county beginning Friday, July 3, for the next two weeks.

“We have seen a rise of cases among younger adults, and these cases are now being linked to higher-risk older adults in our community. We have to slow down the spread of the coronavirus in Douglas County to prevent a surge of cases,” said Douglas County’s Local Health Officer Dr. Thomas Marcellino.
