Total Cases: **4,448** (3,296 Inactive/Past Infectious Period)

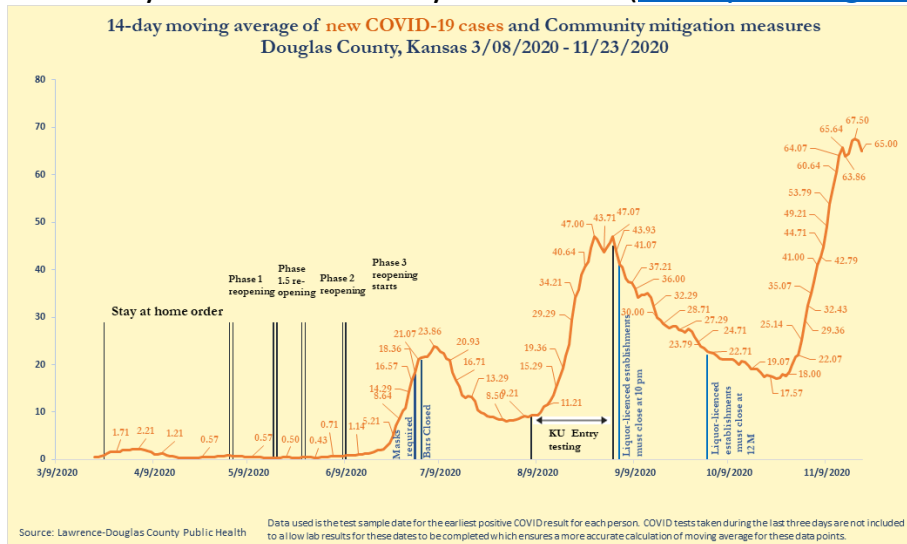
Current Active Cases: **1,152**
