Total Cases: **4,644** (**3,432** Inactive/Past Infectious Period)

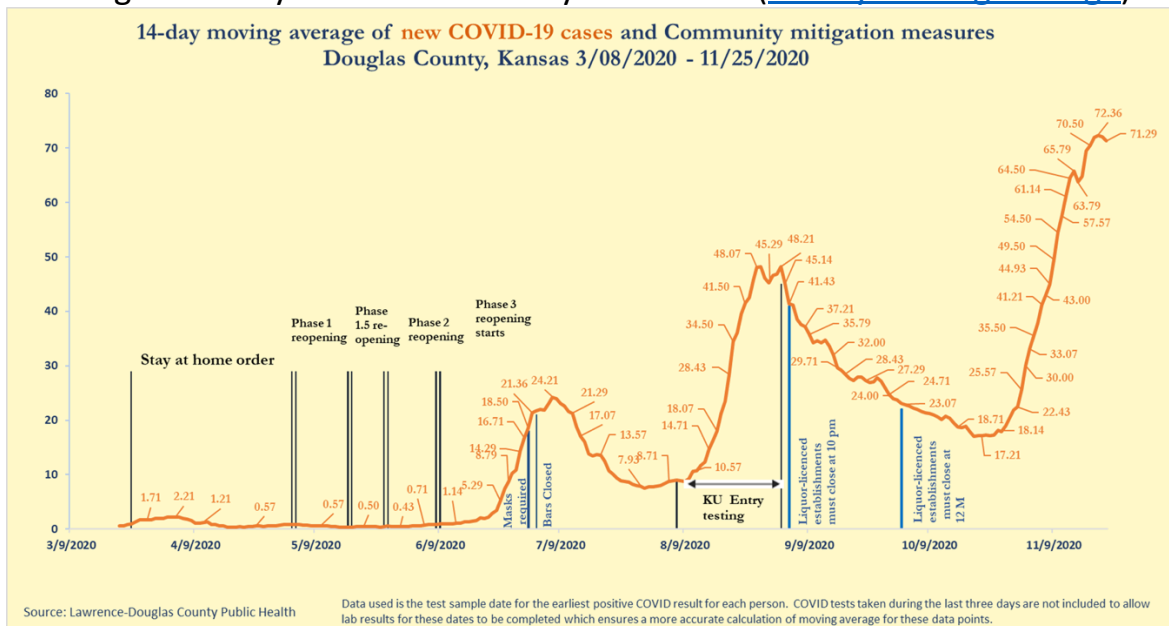
