

# Public Health Recommendations

*Beginning May 27, 2021*

**Strongly Recommend:  
Masks for Anyone older than 2  
when indoors or outdoors in  
public and unable to distance**

(Due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated)

**Especially if:**

- not fully vaccinated
- immunocompromised
- 11 or younger
- In Schools and Healthcare Settings
- On Public Transportation

## Guidance by Sector

### Restaurants & Bars

- ☑ Anyone older than 2 wear a mask indoors or outdoors in public and unable to socially distance due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated.
- ☑ Indoor capacity recommendation is 50% of the lowest occupancy load
- ☑ Seat each dining party 6 feet apart, or use physical barriers to create a separations.
- ☑ Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms and other common touch points
- ☑ Limit touch points by propping open doors, using contactless payment, and use paper, disposable menus
- ☑ Close self-serve food and beverage stations, discontinue buffet service, and remove condiments from tables
- ☑ Seat parties outdoors when possible and discourage seating at the bar
- ☑ Employees recommended to wear masks unless prohibited by other safety equipment and should sanitize hands/change gloves between each guest interaction
- ☑ Screen workers for fevers and any symptoms of COVID
- ☑ Display of signage urging those with fever, symptoms of COVID, or known COVID exposure to not enter
- ☑ Consider keeping a log of guests with contact information of at least one person.

### Parks and Recreation

- ☑ Anyone older than 2 wear a mask indoors or outdoors in public and unable to socially distance due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated.
- ☑ Indoor capacity recommendation is 50% of the lowest occupancy load
- ☑ Maintain 6 feet of distance between individuals and groups and limit spectators at practices
- ☑ Enhanced cleaning of restrooms, doors, and other common touch points
- ☑ Remove any hard-to-clean equipment (e.g. yoga mats, foam rollers, tension bands, bleachers, etc.)
- ☑ Pools may be open
- ☑ Place hand-washing stations or sanitizer near practice or play areas as well as classes
- ☑ Employees recommended to wear masks unless prohibited by other safety equipment
- ☑ Consider use of every other cardio/ weight machine
- ☑ Screen workers for fevers and any symptoms of COVID
- ☑ Display of signage urging those with fever, symptoms of COVID, or known COVID exposure to not enter
- ☑ Consider keeping a log of guests with contact information of at least one person.

### Grocery and Retail Stores

- ☑ Anyone older than 2 wear a mask indoors or outdoors in public and unable to socially distance due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated.
- ☑ Indoor capacity recommendation is 50% of the lowest occupancy load
- ☑ Ensure check-out stations and other work areas are at least 6 feet apart
- ☑ Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms and other common touch points
- ☑ Maintain 6 feet of distance between individuals and groups
- ☑ Employees recommended to wear masks when interacting with the public
- ☑ Screen workers for fevers and any symptoms of COVID
- ☑ Display of signage urging those with fever, symptoms of COVID, or known COVID exposure to not enter

### Libraries

- ☑ Anyone older than 2 wear a mask indoors or outdoors in public and unable to socially distance due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated.
- ☑ Indoor capacity recommendation is 50% of the lowest occupancy load
- ☑ Ensure computers and other work areas are at least 6 feet apart
- ☑ Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms and other common touch points
- ☑ Remove cloth chairs, lounging pillows/areas and anything not able to be easily wiped down and disinfected.
- ☑ Maintain 6 feet of distance between individuals and groups
- ☑ Employees recommended to wear masks when interacting with the public
- ☑ Screen workers for fevers and any symptoms of COVID
- ☑ Display of signage urging those with fever, symptoms of COVID, or known COVID exposure to not enter

### Conferences, Meetings & Events

- ☑ Anyone older than 2 wear a mask indoors or outdoors in public and unable to socially distance due to difficulty of telling who is fully vaccinated.
- ☑ Indoor capacity recommendation is 50% of the lowest occupancy load
- ☑ Maintain 6 feet of distance between individuals and groups
- ☑ Enhanced cleaning and sanitizing of bathrooms and other common touch points
- ☑ Require staff and attendees to wash their hands frequently
- ☑ Prioritize outdoor activities
- ☑ Offer online attendance options in addition to in-person attendance to help reduce the number of in-person attendees.
- ☑ Employees recommended to wear masks when interacting with the public
- ☑ Screen workers for fevers and any symptoms of COVID
- ☑ Display of signage urging those with fever, symptoms of COVID, or known COVID exposure to not enter
